Narcan® (naloxone) Distribution Program

St. Mary's County began the naloxone program in 2014 with a grant from the Maryland Behavioral Health Administration. Initial efforts were concentrated on first responders. The entire St. Mary's County Sheriff's office staff has been trained to administer Narcan®. The program has since expanded to equip the general population with naloxone medication and training.

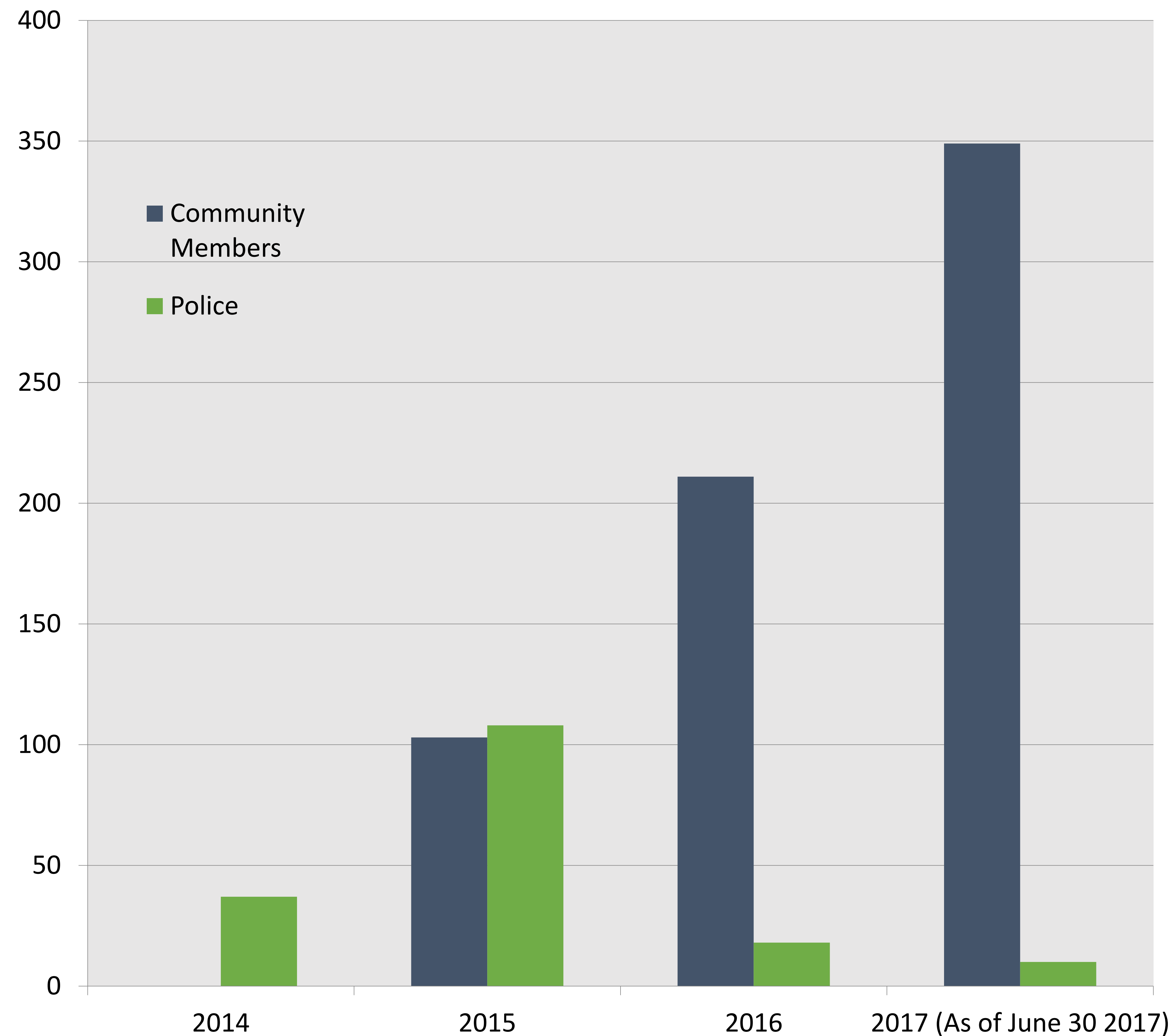
