Benefits

- Apply for food stamps and/or cash assistance by applying online at https://mydhrbenefits.dhr.state.md.us/dashboardClient/#/home. You can also call 240-895-7000 and ask to have an application mailed or emailed to you.
- To apply for emergency assistance, please call 240-895-7000 and ask to have an application mailed or emailed to you (cannot apply online for Emergency Assistance).
- Apply for energy assistance at https://mydhrbenefits.dhr.state.md.us/dashboardClient/#/home (even if denied before - some citizenship requirements need to be met. Even if you have been denied before, you are encouraged to reapply.
- MD health connection is able to do enrollments over phone. Medicaid renewals that would have been cancelled are now open until the end of May. If they need to submit documents, accounts will be considered pending. Governor opened the exchange and it will remain open until 6/15 so they can sign off for insurance. Call Ivanice at (#) for assistance.
- If you want to receive WIC (Special Supplementary Nutritional Program for Women, Infants and Children) for the first time or if you already have it, but your financial situation has changed due to COVID-19, call 1-800-242-4942 to see if you meet the requirements for WIC or additional benefits.
- Maryland Health Connection has opened an emergency special enrollment period for uninsured Marylanders. Medicaid enrollment is open any day if you qualify. Qualified health plan enrollment is extended until June 15, 2020. If you have no insurance, recently lost insurance, lost your job, had a reduction in hours or a change in income, call us now
