## What is the YRBS?

Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) – high school

 National school-based survey conducted by the CDC in partnership with education, health and governmental agencies

 Monitors health-risk behaviors of high school students which contribute to the leading causes of death, disability, and social issues





## YRBS Topics

- Behaviors that contribute to unintentional injuries and violence
- Sexual behaviors related to unintended pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections
- Alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use
- Mental health & suicide risk
- Unhealthy dietary behaviors
- Inadequate physical activity
- Other priority health-related behaviors and conditions among youth





# YRBS 2014 in SMC – Who Participated?

• SMCPS High Schools: 2,208 students

Distributed across 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades (slightly more 9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup>)

Degree of participation allows for general conclusions








