 - * Commission members are asked to serve a two year term. Members may not serve more than two consecutive terms.
 - * Applications must include a letter of recommendation and a resume.
 - * Commission members will be appointed by the Commissioners for St. Mary's County with one representative for each of the five commissioner districts.
