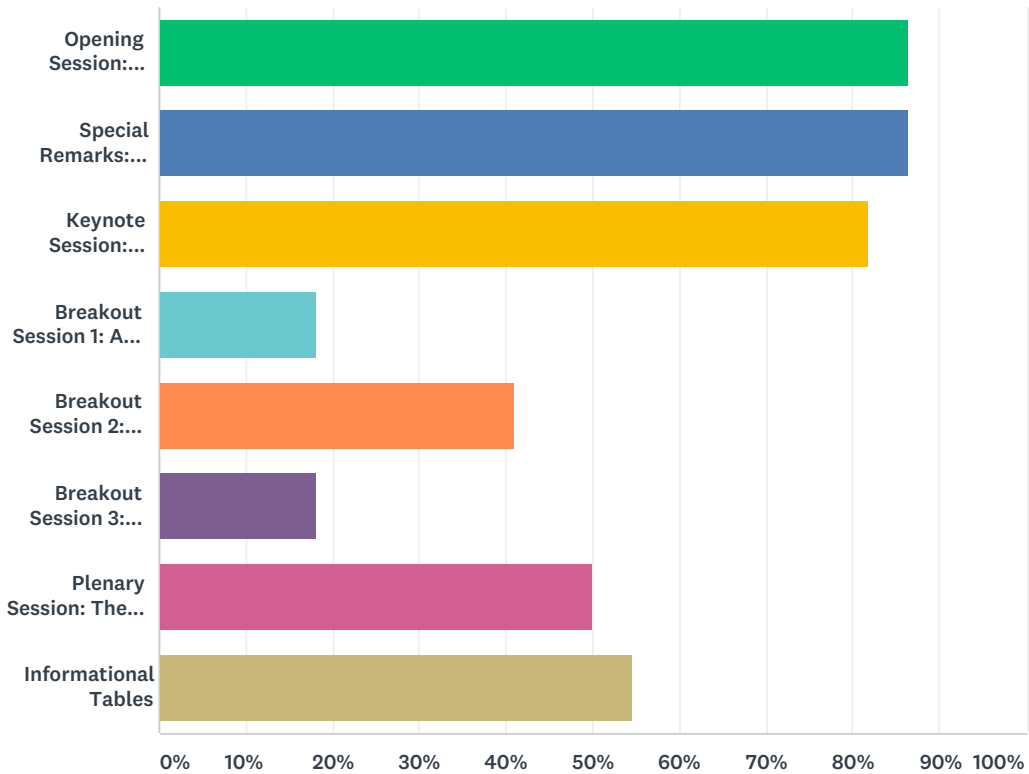

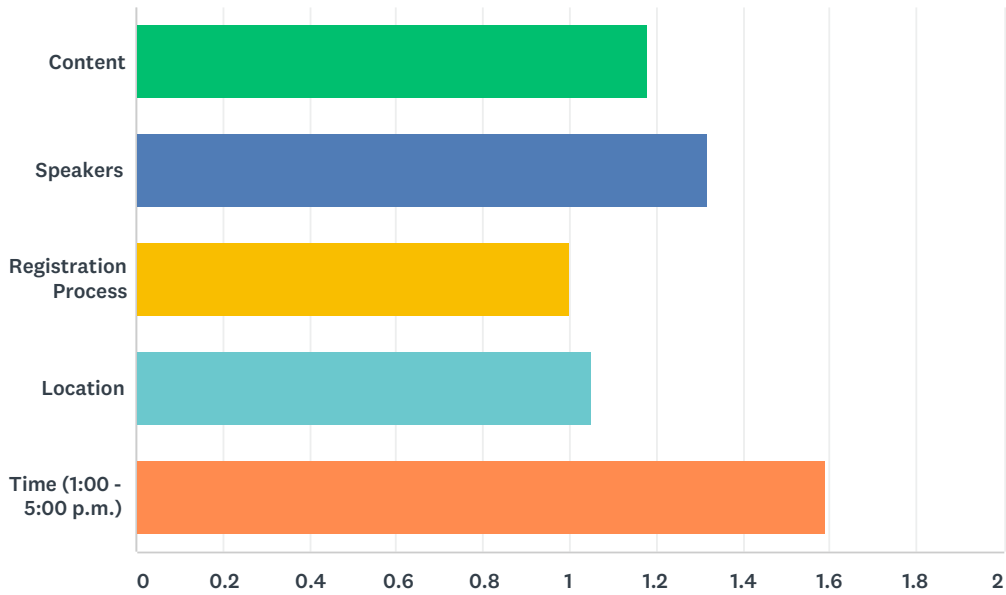
## Q6 In what ways could the meeting have been improved?
