Team Priorities for 2020



- Mental Health Court
 - Greg reached out and got further information in this to help guide us in what data we want to gather. Include data collection from MSMH, courts & SMCSO - outreach in the next month to gather this data.
 - Program Manager for our region - Robert Pointer. It's not the same as drug court - objectives are different.
 - Mental Health Court Committee: Robin, SMCSO rep?
- Mobile Crisis Team
 - 3 proposals received through RFP - 2 submitted to BHA. Notifications out to those 3 proposals.
 - Tri-county proposal that would include crisis beds was also sent up to BHA.
 - Looking to have services begin August 1.
 - If all proposals approved - 24 hour call center, mobile crisis team (16 hour 7 days a week), and crisis beds
 - HSCRC grant due this Sunday
 - MSMH needs letters of support for the HSCRC grant - BHAT can write letter if needed!
- Youth Mentoring
 - Maryland Mentor Survey
 - We're pushing out info on available trainings
 - Botvin LifeSkills Program - SMCHD has 3 slots available

SMCPS Return to School Plan for Mental Health

- Carolyn - Opening Wellness & Recovery Center in Leonardtown on the 28 (T, W, Th 11-3; available at other times for 1:1). Calendar will come out.
- Chris - Virtual training for alcohol retailers & staff - have been offering courses in June/July.
- Kelsey - July 9 - Board of Public Works began budget cuts - LMB funding was cut by 10%

- Patrick - Continue to struggle to place individuals that are leaving in-patient treatment; Hoping to

- Tammy - Vonzella is our new state care coordinator. New adult coordinator starting at the end of the month. Coordination of Homeless Services during COVID that was a collaboration between multiple local organizations - 37 individuals have been placed in housing and a few others who are in treatment services and then have options for housing after. 211 has increased in utilization statewide.
