- **1. HB0134/SB0177: Business Regulation – Flavored Tobacco Products – Prohibition**

Tobacco Tax Veto Override Update

- HB732: Taxation - Tobacco Tax, Sales and Use Tax, and Digital Advertising Gross Revenues Tax (*from 2020 Legislative Session*)
 - House and Senate both voted to override the Governor's veto. This law will go into effect 30 days from 2/12/21.
