Adult ACEs data	64.5% of adults over the age of 18 stated that they had experienced at least 1 childhood adversity and 23% stated that they had experienced at least 3 childhood adversities		
Suicide rates	suicide rate (per 100,000 population) in St. Mary's County from 2014 - 2018 was 11; middle school youth showed that 19.4% of the students reported having had suicidal thoughts in the past year. 20.8% of high school students reported having seriously considered attempting suicide and 16.4% reported they had made a plan about how they would attempt suicide in the past year; Higher percentages of gay, lesbian, or bisexual high school students in St. Mary's County reported having seriously considered attempting suicide (50.8%) and reported they had made a plan about how they would attempt suicide in the past year (40.7%) than their heterosexual peers (16.1% and 12.5%).	Data is a bit lagged, but very informative. Lots of strategies to address.
