Youth Dating Violence/Domestic Violence

- The team would like to host more Youth Dating Violence-themed events in the future
 - Year-long focus?
 - Events in October and February
 - Commission for Women & Family Violence Coordinating Council did some brainstorming
 - October "Why Don't They Just Leave" panel event
 - Highlighting resources in the community & holes in local services as well as having a survivor share their story
 - Can pull from the Family Violence Coordinating Council to pull together panelists
 - Three Notch Theater to do a short skit
 - Marta, Norma, and Taylor will lead the planning and bring to the team any action items they need help with!
 - Pull together campaign that highlights resources as well as education around the different types of domestic/dating violence
 - Taylor (SMCFA) has some materials from previous campaigns that we can pull from
 - Action Item:
 - Think of other event ideas/potential speakers

Suicide Prevention Education for Parents

- Last month, the team discussed in detail the importance of parental involvement in teen suicide prevention and mental health, as well as the need for parental resources on how to address it.
- We are looking to put together a "Parent's Toolkit for Suicide Prevention" 'what now?' style
 - "Beyond the 911" What can parents expect when they call 911 for their child? Expectations, resources available, custody questions
 - If you are interested in helping to gather information, please let us know!
 - Robin, Alexis, Maryellen, Greg, MSMH rep? Regina Russell
 - Need to pull together resources to include
 - SMCPS' After-care Program
 - The problem with this program is it's been hard to have parents inform the school when their child has been admitted and is returning to school
 - Robin has a list of resources they've pulled together
 - Alexis Higdon (St. Mary's County Sheriff's Office)
 - Discuss her program in the guide

Suicide Prevention Education for Parents (continued)

- Decision: Do we only include the limited services in St. Mary's or expand the service area included?
 - There was an extended conversation regarding the frustration expressed by parents due to the limitation of services at MSMH if their child is EP-ed there
 - St. Mary's will only treat children ages 16+, while Calvert will treat ages 12+, causing some parents to take their younger children straight to Calvert county hospitals for treatment.
- It was concluded that Maryland as a whole has a limitation for youth services & especially right now there is an exceptional need
- We can make the completed toolkit available for parents through Emergency Services, MSMH, and schools (public and private).
- Discussed a possible CalvertHealth partnership with Sheppard Pratt?
- Upon completion of the toolkit, the team discussed hosting a panel event, walking through the process & highlighting the available resources.
- Brandon Russell is working to put together a "Community Against Violence" event. He will keep the team informed as they move forward!

Advocacy Agenda

- The team viewed and discussed the <u>2022 Bills of Interest</u>
 - <u>SB94/HB48</u> (Maryland Suicide Fatality Review Committee)
 - Both versions have crossed over to opposite chamber
 - We can write letter of support for committee hearings
 - In the House Hearing 3/30 at 1:30 p.m.
 - Partners can reach out to local officials to indicate support
