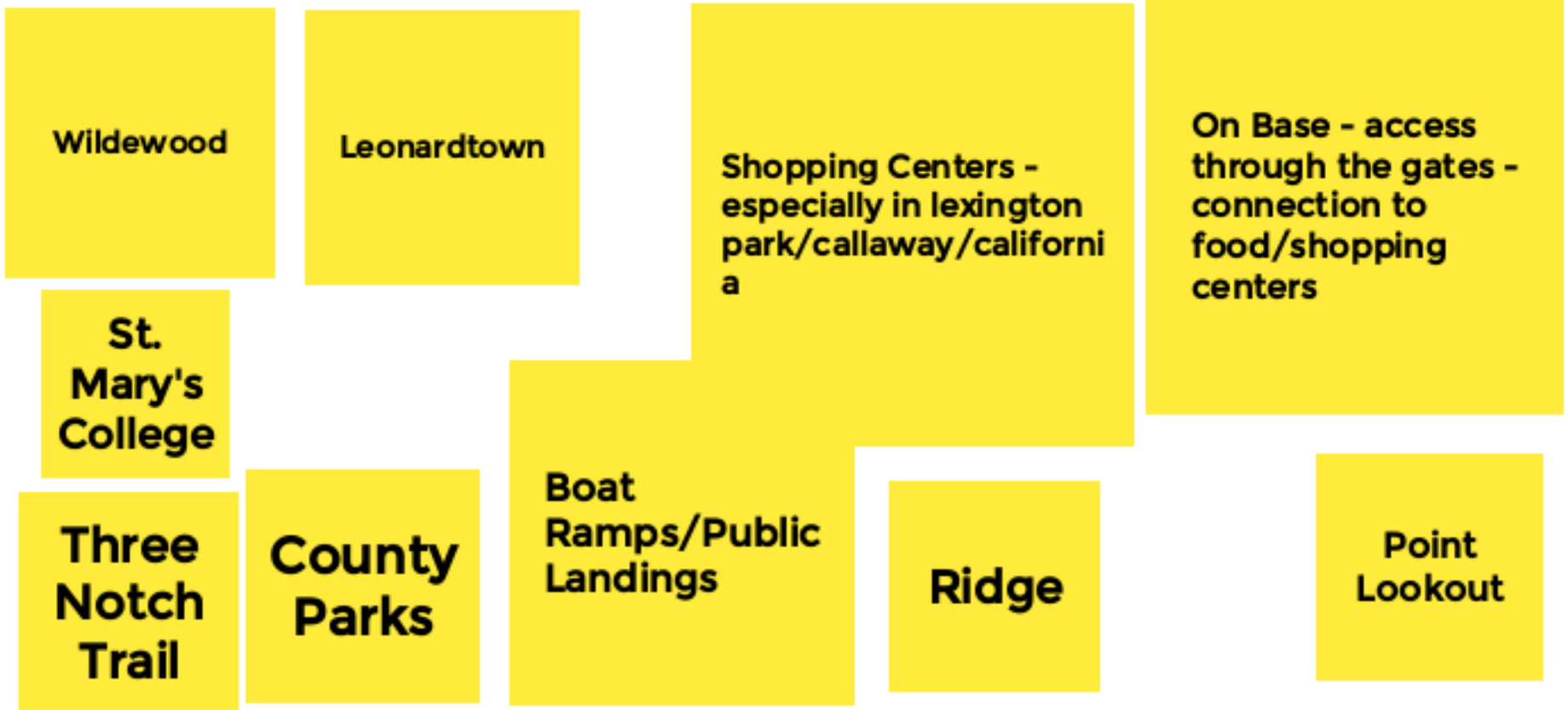


What locations do you want a bike share?



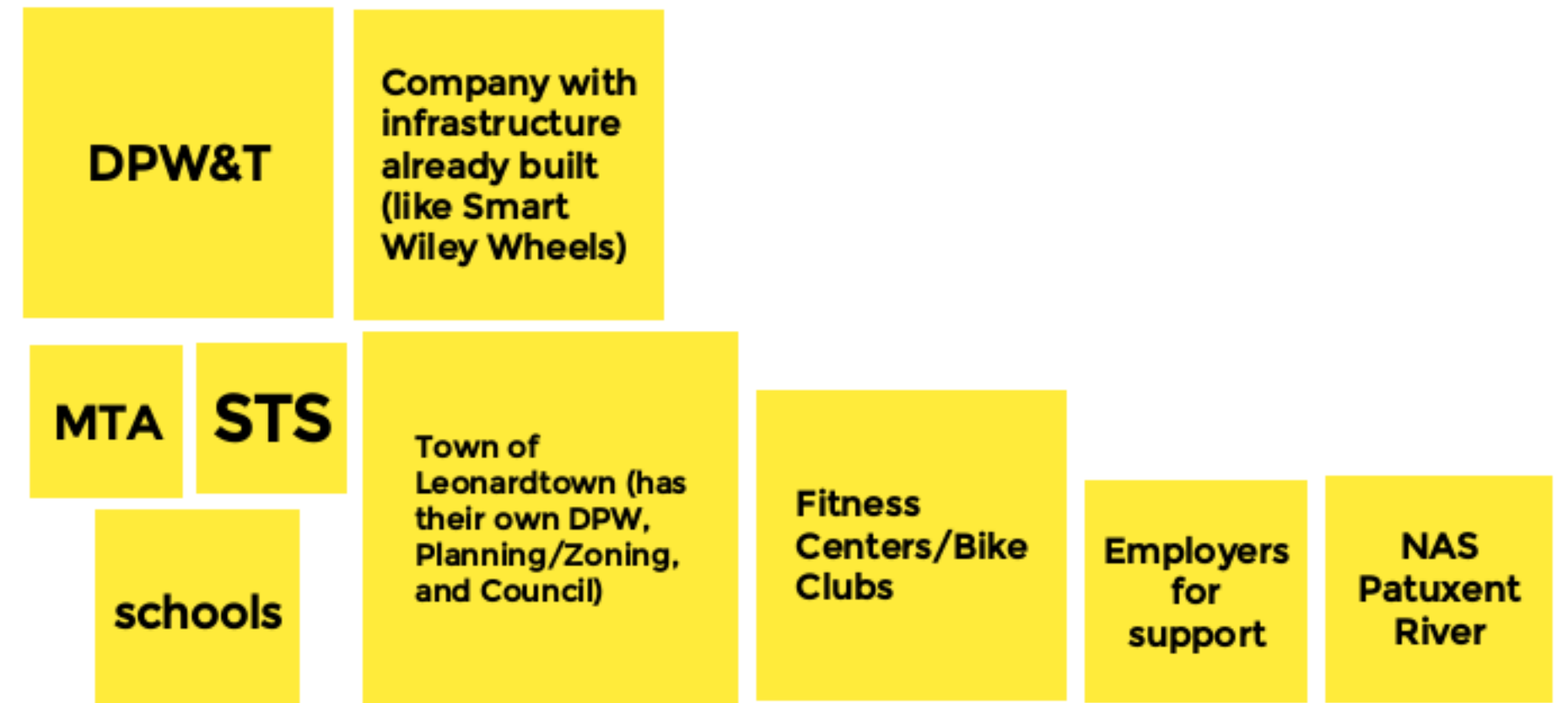
How can we encourage or incentivize participation in the bike share program?

Solutions

Station-based bike share - best for county parks, recreational areas, point lookout, and library & college

There's no one size fits all for our county. Leonardtown - bike library that is staffed (especially on weekends). Lexington Park - smart bikes may work better. Three Notch Trail - kiosks (one at each end and 1 in the middle).

Electric bike - helps with those who are not in "bike-shape" (think of all of the hills!)

Electric-assist bikes would be beneficial since it is such a large county.

without the kiosk. Database run. Locked/unlocked through phone or app. This can provide data and ability for free rides. Memberships so you can offer rides at discounts. Weekend rates where you could keep the bike out for

Hybrid - adapted for each location

BIKE LIBRARY - adapted from place to place. Manned vs unmanned in locations based on need. Need tracking/database run system. Need covid/cleaning protocols. There are places in the community that are available to be utilized

Hybrid program most feasible

Think about if bikes have weight restrictions?

KIOSK system (easy to return to the same place). Lexington Park - Lancaster park and focus on recreational riding to start with. Bike donation program for Lexington Park (used bikes donated for those who want to use the bike to commute).

Smart bikes in more rural places because they can be locked up anywhere

Bike Library is nice easy way to start, but without the limitations of round trip. Set up the drop off locations in easy access places.

Implementation process - start with something low-cost to pilot it. Once you've made it through the pilot, expand to implement the electric bikes with geofencing.

Linking the bike stations to transit stops so that you can hop on STS bus. Racks on the buses.
