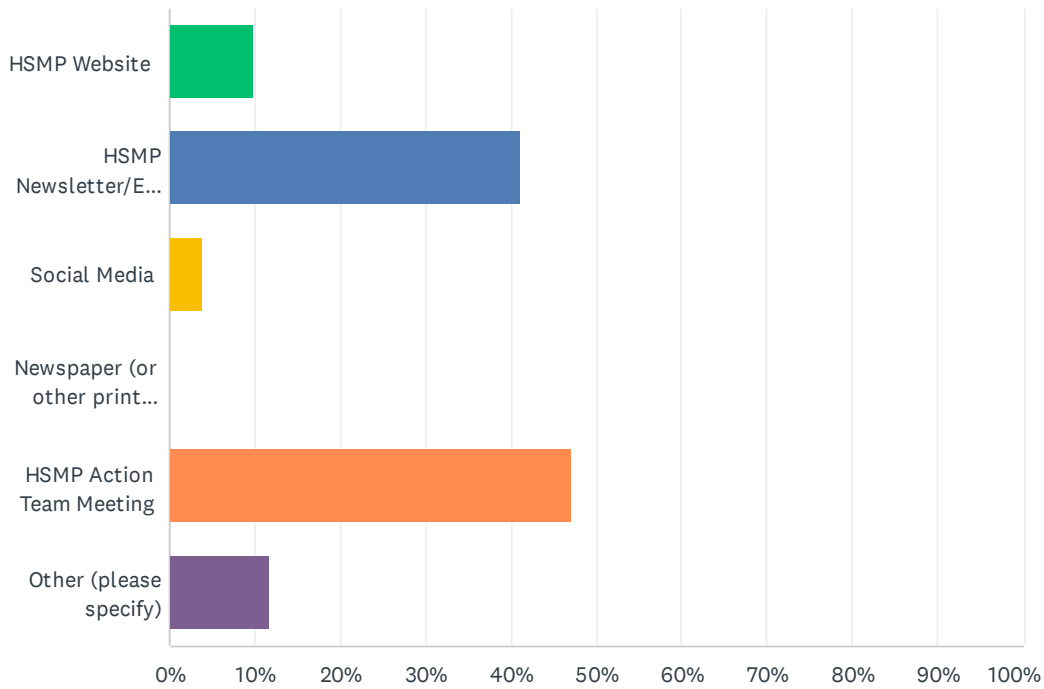


Q1 How did you hear about the 2022 HSMP Annual Meeting?

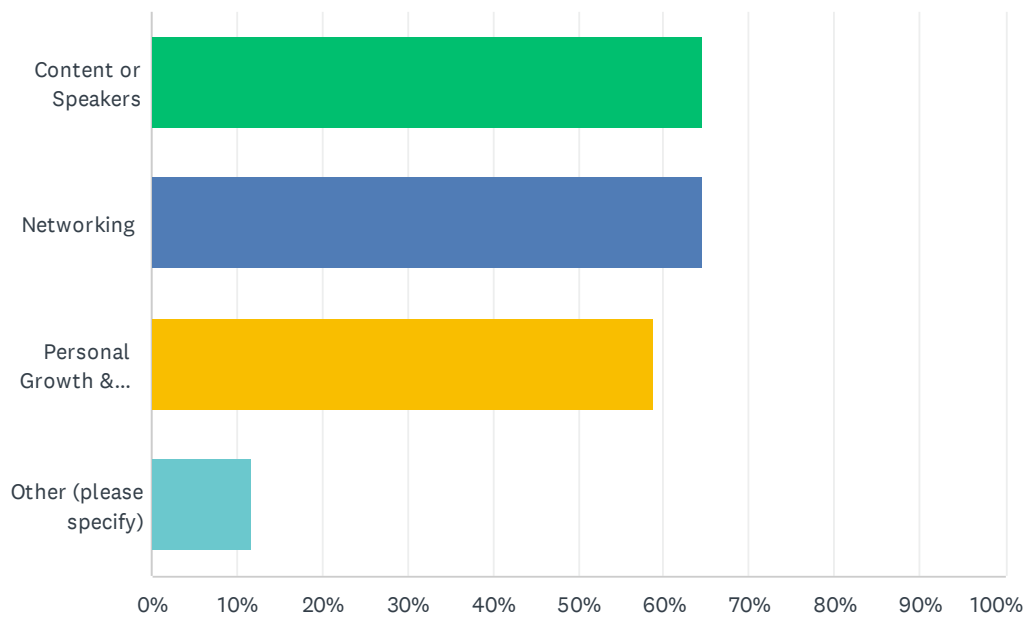

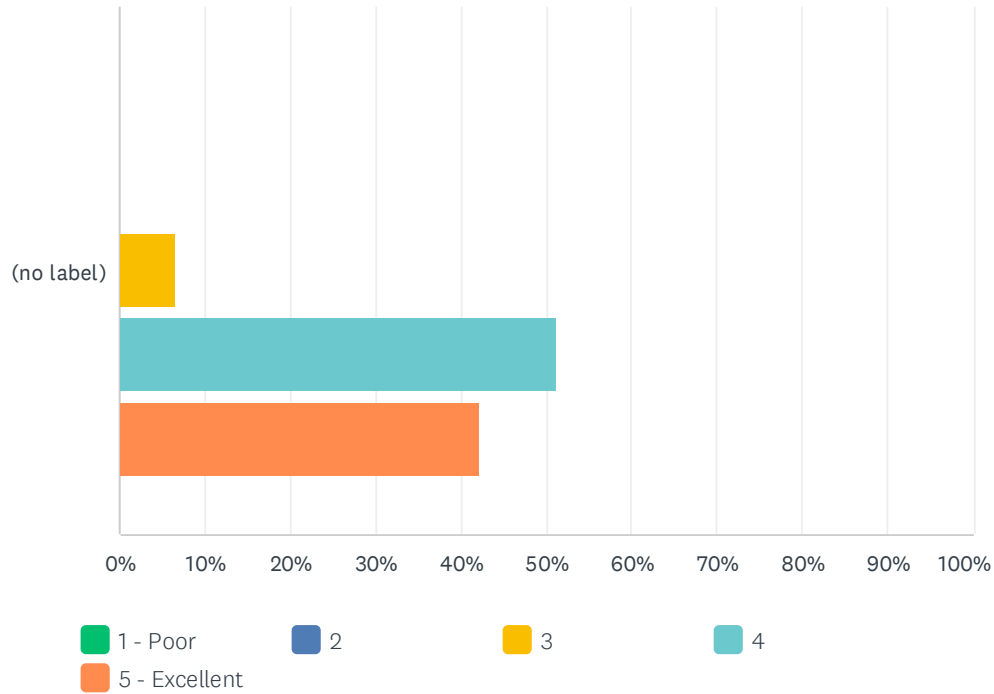

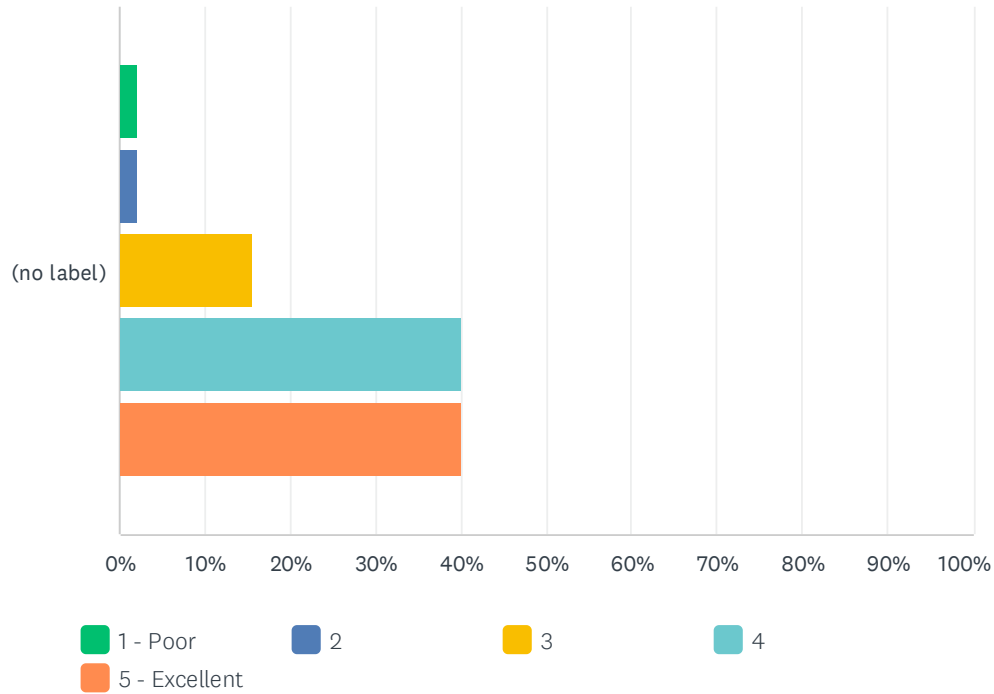

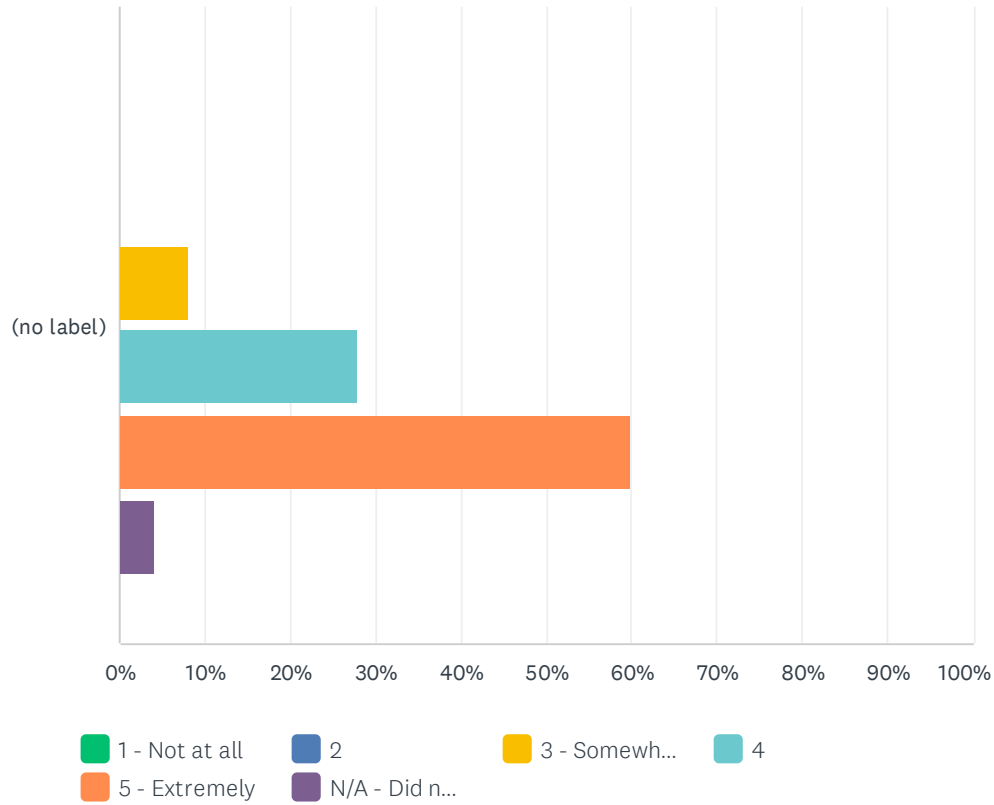

Q5 How useful was the information provided during the HSMP Updates Opening Session?

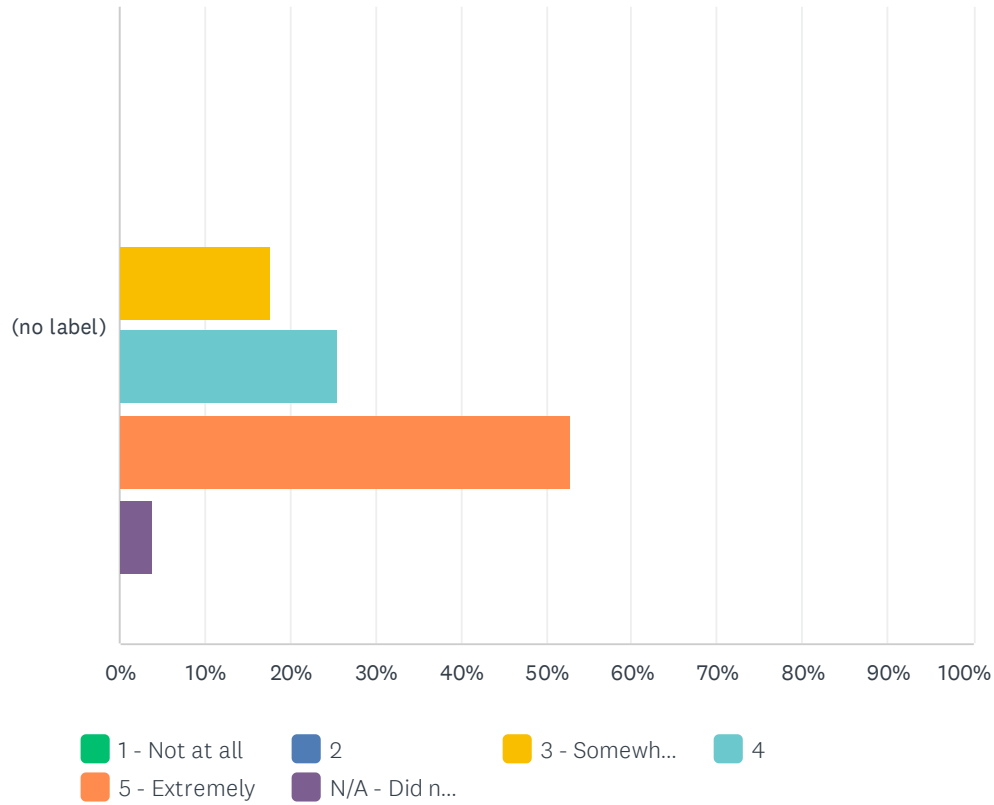

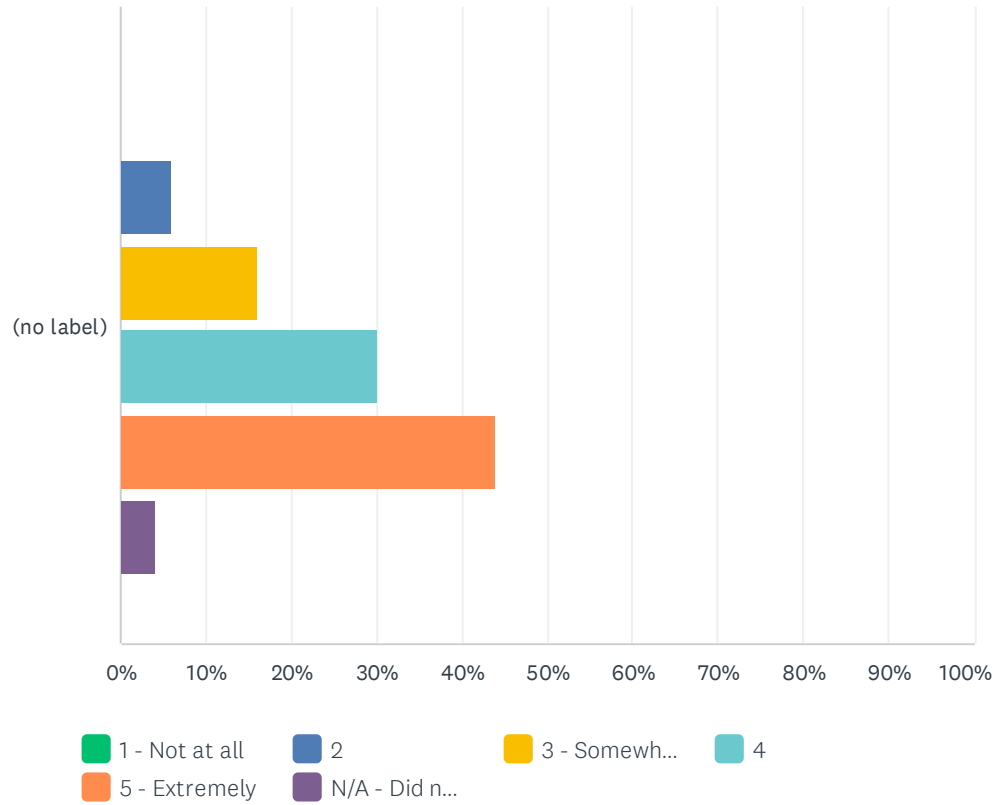

Q7 How useful was the information provided in the American Heart Association Program Highlights session?

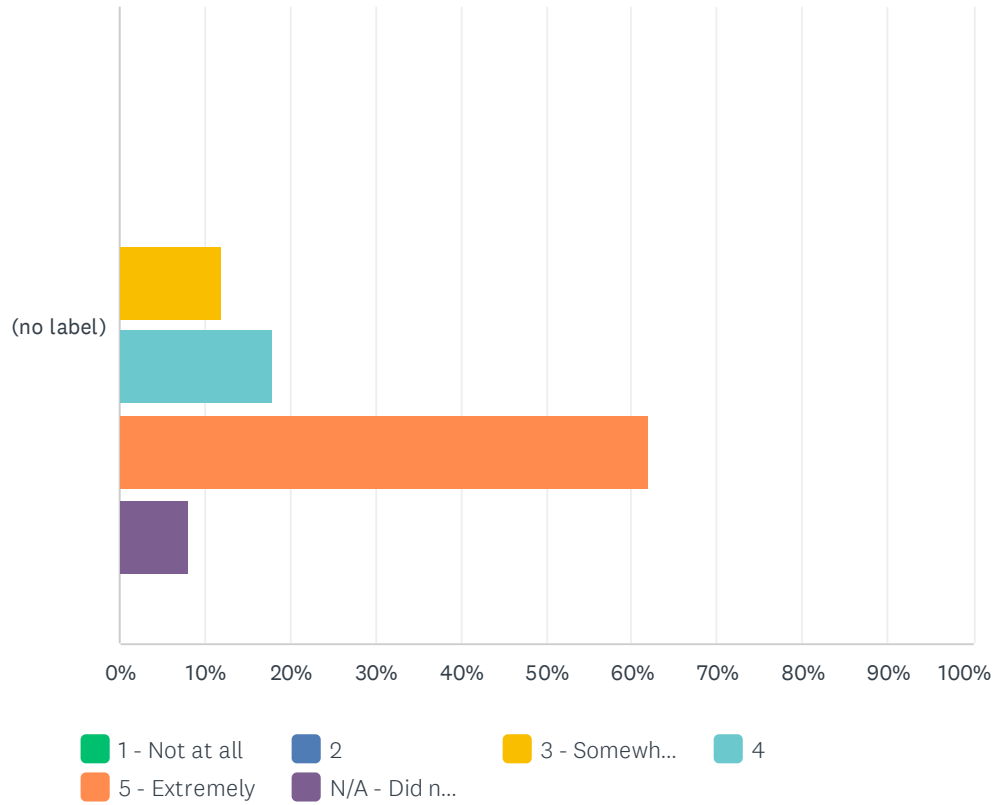

Q8 How useful was the information provided in the Reducing Gun Violence in our Communities session?

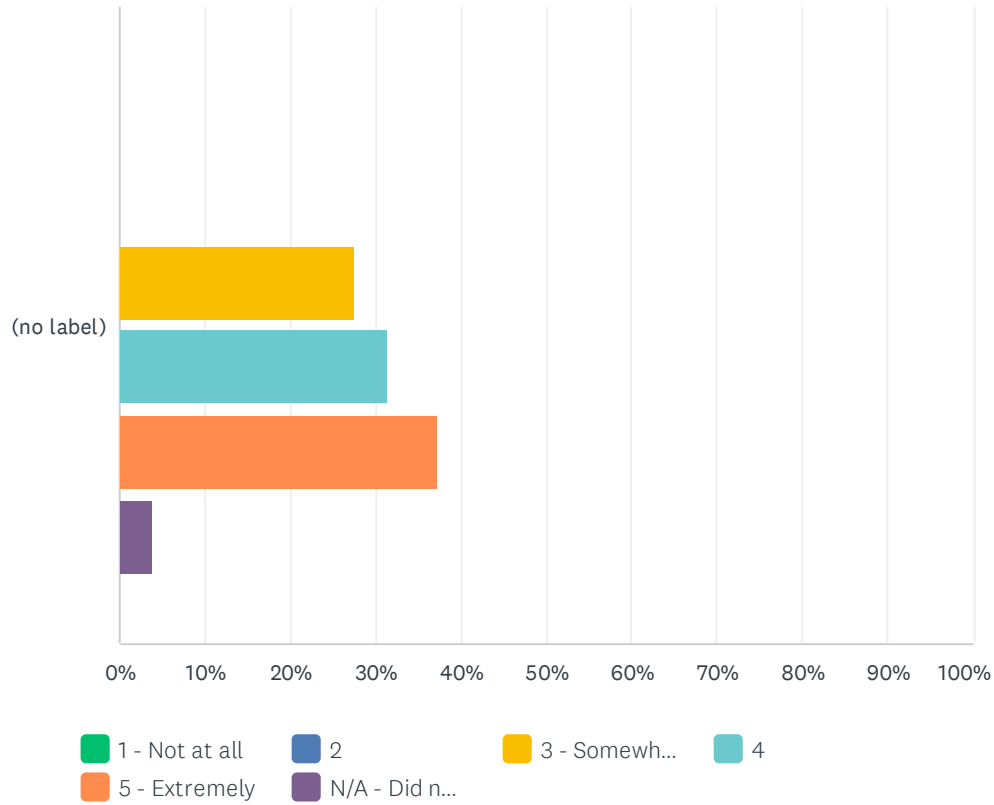

Q9 How useful was the information provided in the Mapping Food Insecurity in Maryland session?

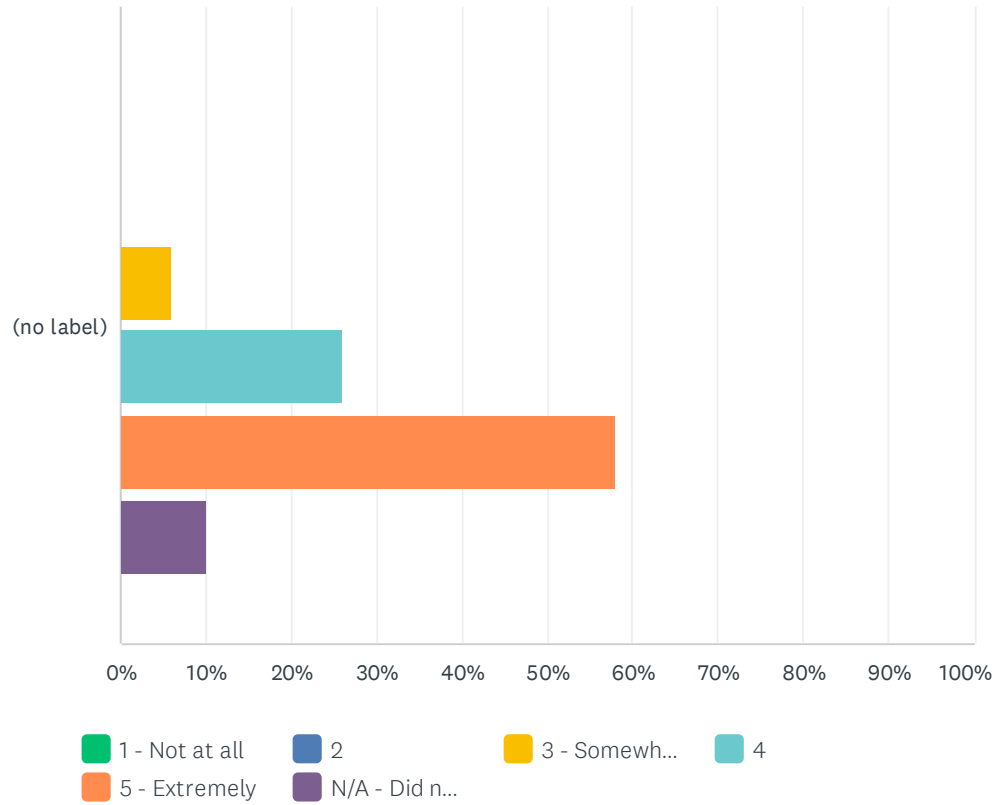

Q10 How useful was the information provided by the St. Mary's County Health Hub panel session?

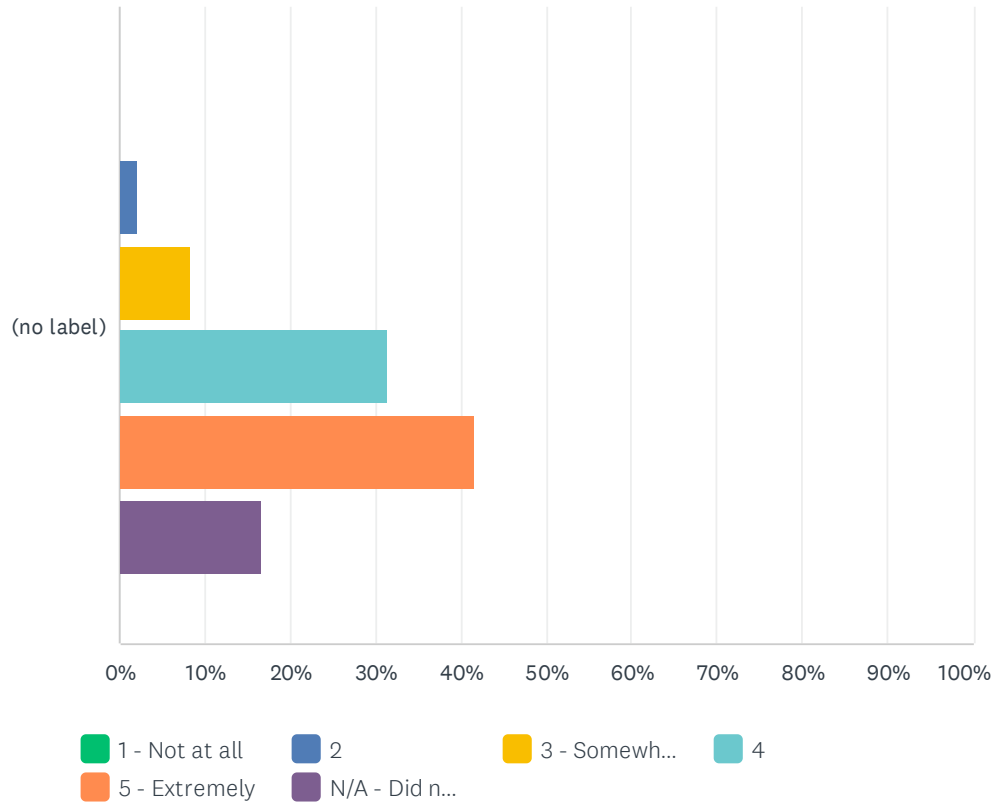
