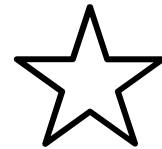




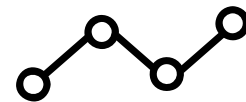
Mentorship Program



Our youth mentorship program is a structured program that involves the matching of youth to a trained adult or peer mentor for a year or longer. We also provide SEL after-school mentoring programs for schools and communities.



We have provided mentorship to youth and young adults for 6 years from ages 7 to 25 years old.



Mentors are important to at-risk youth to help young people avoid negative behaviors and achieve success. Our youth with mentors have increased likelihood of going to college, better attitudes toward school, increased social and emotional development, and improved self-esteem



Our Focus: to encourage youth to have a sense of belonging, guidance, and inspiration to make positive choices and become productive citizens.

Peer to Peer

Mentees are paired with a trained 11th or 12th grader mentor

School-Centered

Mentees meet in a community setting with peer and adult mentors

One to One

Mentees are paired with a trained adult mentor

Academic

Mentees are paired with an adult who can provide assistance with school performance

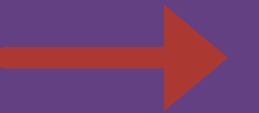
Mentors

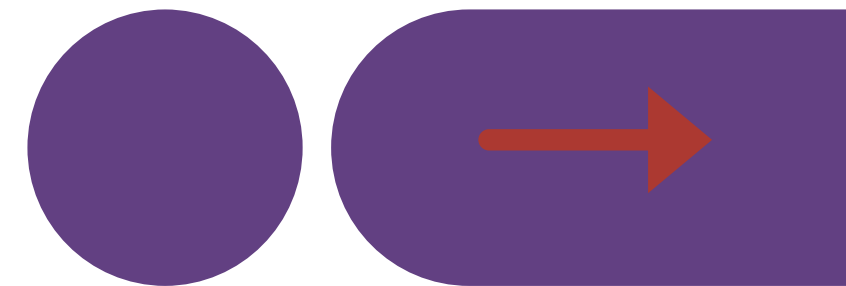
