Beginning August 2022, the St. Mary's County Health Department, St. Mary's County Libraries, and the Healthy St. Mary's Partnership are pleased to offer wheel-chair accessible telehealth booths at the **Lexington Park and Charlotte Hall libraries**. These telehealth booths provide a private space with reliable internet access for community members to reserve and use for virtual healthcare visits.
