Violent Crimes

- Data sources to review
 - Youth Risk Behavior Survey, YRBS Shan will review
 - Juvenile arrests
 - Department of Juvenile Services provided a <u>report</u>
 - St. Mary's County Teen Court
 - Stephanie reached out to Gregory Jones for data on the number of youth referred, participated and who have successfully completed the program
 - Local Management Board (LMB) Shan will reach out to Amanda Meatyard
 - SMCSO's Gun Violence Data
 - Firearm Related Offences Involved Persons up to 25 years of age
- We will review these data in conjunction with our local assets (<u>list of</u> <u>programs/resources</u>) and perform a gap analysis to determine what services are missing and which age group(s) need assistance the most

Suicidal Thoughts

- The VIT co-chairs have partnered with BHAT's Family Education Subcommittee to address parental education and how parents can best help their child/teen with their mental and behavioral health
- Maryland Response Corps (MRC)
- Consider organizing a support group for grieving friends/family members
 - Hospice partnership (bereavement coordinator <u>Dawn Kelly</u>)
 - Shan will continue to follow up with Dawn
 - Ideas for grief counseling, church group, retreat for grieving parents
 - Partnering with Camp Maria for a retreat and involving The Cove kids in a summer event
 - Sharing AFSP's list of support groups
- Shan shared the concept of a <u>LOSS Team Model</u> "Local Outreach to Suicide Survivors" - an active postvention model; involves two or more volunteers, called a LOSS Team, proactively going to the scene of a suicide to provide immediate support to those left behind
 - How to Launch a LOSS Team
 - Potential interest in starting one in St. Mary's County?

Partner Updates

- SMCHD is onboarding two new providers who will be primarily focusing on adolescent substance use.
- Starting July 1, non-citizen pregnant Marylanders who would otherwise be eligible for Medicaid but for their immigration status may now be eligible for coverage. View the <u>flyer</u> or <u>Healthy Babies Equity Act</u> overview.
