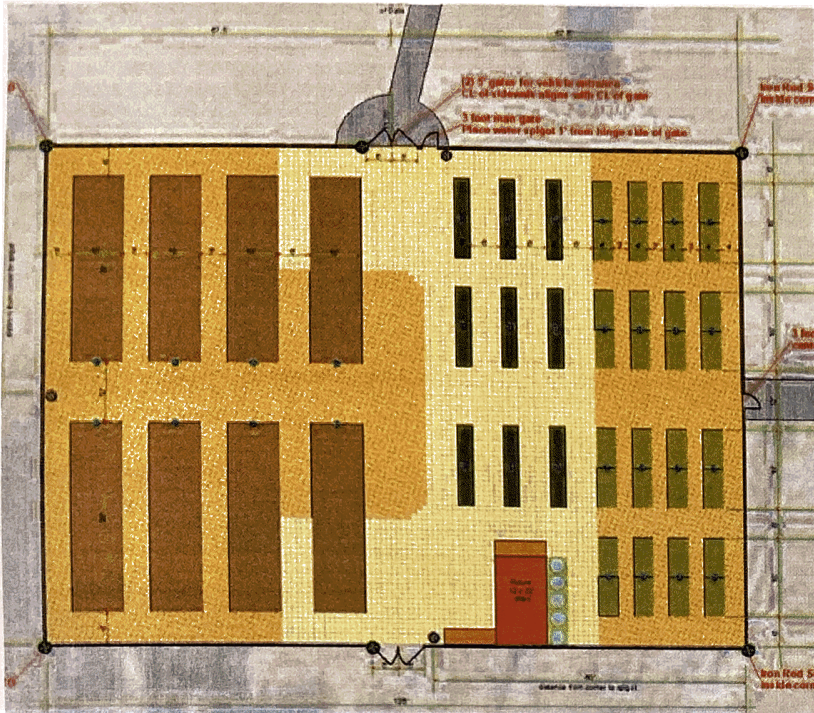

- Raised beds (16")
- ADA planters on legs
- Garden Plots
- Shed (20' x 10' with 1 foot overhang front and back)
- Potting bench (3' D x 10') - 1 @ standing ht and 1 @ ADA ht
- Fenced area (100' x 135' inside) 8' chain link w/ pair of 5' gates centered in fence for access
- Rain barrels
- ADA surface (tiles extend under ADA planters & potting benches)
- Straw mulch over newspaper
- ADA Sidewalk
- Compost*
- 8' Chainlink fence with gates as shown

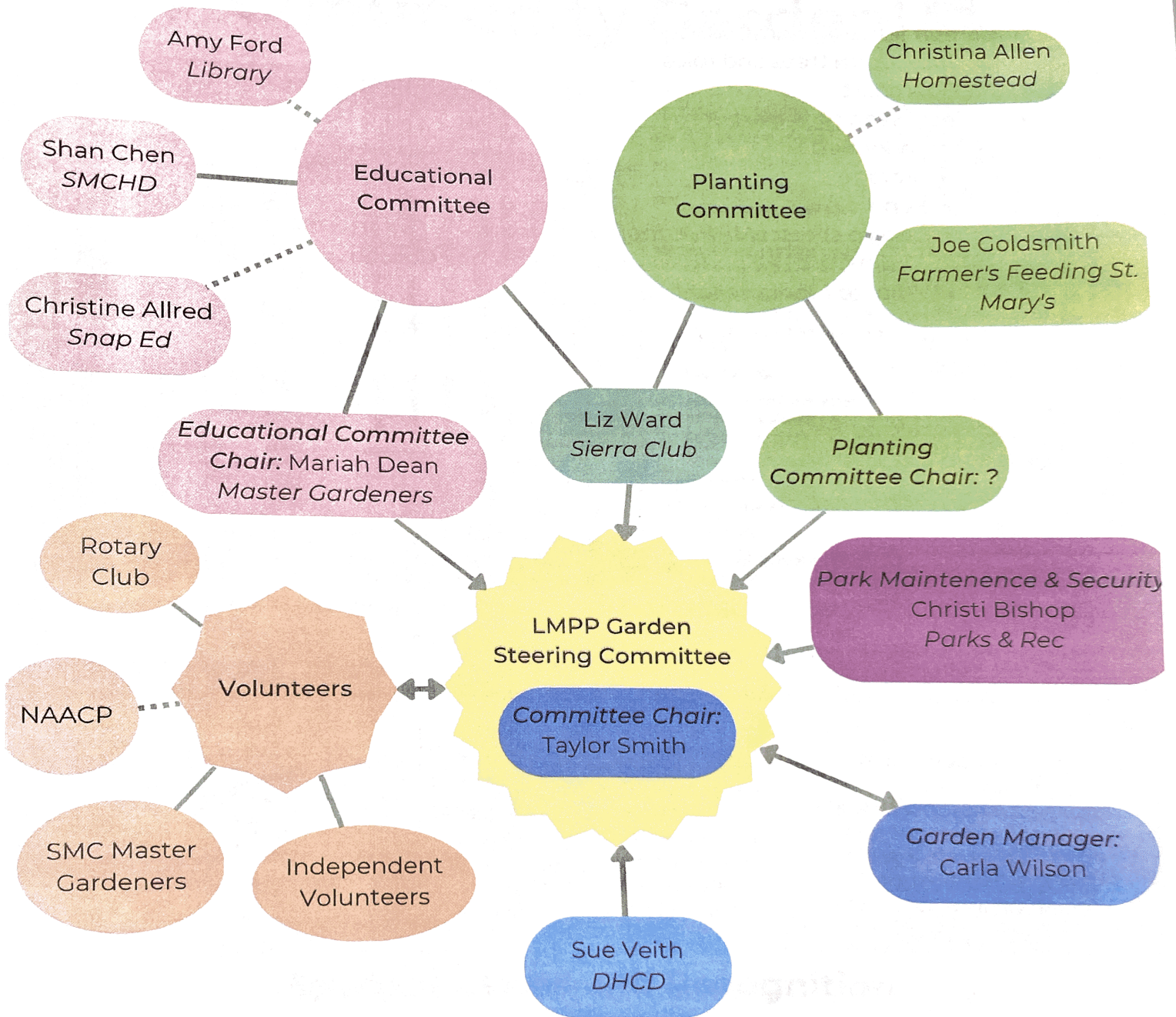
