- HSMP's VIT Action Team will be tabling at the <u>2nd Annual Parent & Family Engagement Title I</u> <u>Conference</u> and is seeking volunteers! The event is this Saturday, July 29 at Green Holly Elementary School, from 8:30 am - 3:00 pm.

- Kelsey shared a July 26 Baltimore Sun article on how the availability of youth recreation centers help to lower juvenile delinquency
- The team is continuing to obtain and review the following data:
 - Youth Risk Behavior Survey, YRBS Shan will review
 - Department of Juvenile Services provided a <u>report</u> on arrests
 - Stephanie reached out to St. Mary's County Teen Court (Gregory Jones) last month; still waiting for a response.
 - Local Management Board (LMB) Shan will reach out to Amanda Meatyard
 - SMCSO shared its <u>Firearm Related Offences</u> Report
- Sgt. Austin Schultz of St. Mary's County Sheriff's Office spoke about the newly formed Criminal Intelligence Unit (CIU) Task Force, which mirrors the duties of its predecessor, the Youth Gun Violence Task Force. They continue to execute warrants, make arrests and seize firearms in efforts to curb gun violence in St. Mary's County.
 - There was a discussion on local partners working together to compile community resources on violence prevention

Suicidal Thoughts

- BHAT-VIT Family Education Subcommittee updates
 - Looking at best practices, successful models
 - Working on a Parent Resource "Menu" in the form of a website landing page and a one-pager (QR code to link to webpage).
 - Deadline: August 23, when students return to school
 - <u>Email Shan</u> for a calendar invitation to join the biweekly meetings! The next meeting is Wednesday, August 2 from 9:00 am - 10:00 am.
- Support groups for grieving friends and family members
 - There is a potential interest in starting a LOSS (Local Outreach to Suicide Survivors) Team in St. Mary's County. A <u>LOSS Team</u> is made up of trained suicide loss survivors, and sometimes other concerned community members, that go to the scene of a suicide to support those left behind.
 - Currently, there are no active LOSS teams in Maryland
- SMCHD's Behavioral Health Division is working on developing resources for individuals coping with crisis situations or critical incidents.
- It was suggested to reach out to veteran organizations to share resources pertaining to suicide prevention and loss.
- National Night Out is taking place August 1 in <u>neighborhoods across St. Mary's County!</u>
 - SMCHD will be present at Wildewood and Nicolet Park
