 - Rolling out the letter:

 - We will develop a survey to see if implementation of the letter is helping clients to connect, and to track how they are being used.
 - The team considered the month of January for a follow-up and review with providers.

- A Health Equity Subcommittee was formed to address community members living in more rural areas of St. Mary's County.
 - Barbara O'Neal expressed that many residents in Ridge are unaware of the resources available to them, and many have unreliable internet/cell service to access digital resources or flyers using QR codes.
 - Looking to identify target areas in the community and then campaigning directly to those communities to promote resources available. Proposed solutions are:
 - Team door-to-door canvassing to promote awareness of resources. We'll send a notice out asking for volunteers in advance of the door to door canvassing, so you can work it into your schedule.
 - Volunteer/conduct outreach at local target areas like in Clements at farm stand, Ridge shred days, Bingo, etc.
