- "Walk With A Doc" Updates:
 - The walk on September 30 at MedStar St. Mary's Hospital from 10am-am was successful with 8 attendees.
 - The second event was postponed to the rain date of October 28 at Lexington Manor Passive Park from 9:30am-11:30am. Please note this is a time change from previous announcements due to provider availability.
 - Aniko met with Temeria Wilcox to discuss he participation and she has agreed to join us as the provider for this event.

Transportation

- The team discussed pinning the SMC Bike Share Program for now, as we need the infrastructure to support biking first.
- Action item: Shan and Aniko will email Nate Evans, the State Bicycle Coordinator, and invite him to the next subcommittee meeting to discuss bicycle plans in Southern Maryland and St. Mary's County and get input on what criteria would make a bike infrastructure project more likely to be funded.
 - The next grant period is in mid-June/early July, so we have time to prepare.
- The Secretary of Transportation presented to the County Commissioners on October 17. His team mentioned some funding that was recently awarded to the county (including bikeways grant & three notch trail phase 7).
 - Please take some time to review the recording of this presentation to learn about FY 24 & 25 items.
- Recreation & Parks updates:
 - Christi shared information about the Three Notch Trail Phase 7 project. This phase includes a 3.3 mile section from by Harris Teeter north to the old Hollywood Rescue Squad future location (now owned by the county and will be a new trailhead with parking and potentially a future bike share location). The county is hoping to have this submitted for permitting this fall and then go to bid next fiscal year for construction.
 - Christi will share more about bikeways grant soon.
- Action Item: Shan/Aniko will coordinate with <u>Ashlyn Dishman</u> to schedule a subcommittee meeting.
- Tri-County Council held its BIAC meeting on September 14.
 - They are widening parts of Three Notch Trail and are working on a regional transportation priority letter soon.
 - Their next meeting is on December 14 at 12:30. Email <u>Jessica Richards</u> for more information.
- The Transportation Association of Maryland issued their policy agenda for the 2024 Legislative Session.

Food Security

- During the 2023 HSMP Annual Meeting's interactive planning session, meeting attendees worked together on a <u>poster</u> focusing on food security. Find notes from all of the projects from the planning session <u>here</u>.
- SoMD Fridges Program Update:
 - We are continuing to look for potential fridge sites. St. Mary's Caring, The Mission, The Church of The Ascension have been contacted for their input and will need follow up.
 - Charles County has 24 hour lighting and security cameras on the fridge.
 - We discussed Three Oaks as potential site for the fridge in St. Mary's County.
- Bag Hunger SoMD on October 7 was a big success!
 - We packaged 60,000 servings of fortified Mac & Cheese for distribution through the local pantries.
- Promoting healthy food drives:
 - Following the Annual Meeting, HSMP donated 2 boxes of food to St. Mary's County Health Hub's Food Pantry and to the homeless community on Great Mills Rd!
 - Employees of St. Mary's County did a food drive at their Health & Wellness Day and were able to donate 6 boxes of food.
 - Please encourage event organizers to implement a Healthy Food Drive at their event, using the toolkit on the HSMP website!
 - Sue Veith will be including the toolkit in the newsletter they send to businesses regularly.
 - Action Item: The team decided to add language to the Healthy Meeting Toolkit that will assist in food waste/donation after events.
- HSMP's Food Pantry Platform is in development! More information coming soon. Jacquie and Aniko have a meeting about the platform this afternoon.
