Transportation

- Nate Evans, the Active Transportation Planner at Maryland Department of Transportation, provided updates on upcoming projects:
 - R&P's newly awarded \$1.2 million Bikeways grant from MDOT to complete construction of the Phase 7 of the Three Notch Trail. Construction is expected to begin early 2024.
 - MDOT is finishing up its draft 2050 Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan, which provides guidance on best practices for bicycle, pedestrian and micro mobility infrastructure and programming for state & local jurisdictions. It will be finalized in January.
 - He also shared a <u>list of grant programs</u> for Maryland jurisdictions.
 - We will review this list, note deadlines for grants of interest, and prepare the paperwork in advance in order to have adequate time for applying.
 - Sue shared <u>information</u> on Maryland pedestrian and bicycle funding programs.
- The team discussed forming a work group focused on grant applications to include:
 - DPW Rep, TCC Rep (George Clark/Jessica Richards), Regional Planner (Sean Varsolona)
 - We will consider combining it with the Bike Share Interest Subcommittee.
 - Ashlyn and Shan will hold off coordinating a subcommittee meeting until January/February in hopes of including Nate Evans in the discussion.
- Tri-County Council is holding its next BIAC meeting on December 14 from 12:00-2:00 pm. If you would like an invitation, send an email to <u>Jessica Richards</u>.
- The Transportation Association of Maryland issued their <u>policy agenda</u> for the 2024 Legislative Session.

Food Security

- SoMD Fridges Program Update:
 - Shan and Jacquie are meeting with Kristine Millen of St. Mary's Caring this Thursday to discuss program initiatives.
 - Ascension Pantry has requested more information on the program.
 - <u>The Middle Mile Program</u> can be a resource on HSMP's webpage It is a food distribution program that collects unused food from businesses to be redistributed to Maryland food bank partners.
 - DED is working on a newsletter article on food waste.
- Promoting healthy food drives:
 - <u>Action Item</u>: The team decided to add language to the Healthy Meeting Toolkit that will assist in food waste/donation after events.

- HSMP's Food Pantry Platform is in development! Shan met with the developers last Tuesday to discuss updates. We are currently reaching out to local food pantries to obtain up-to-date contact information in order to create their profiles in the platform.

Partner Updates

- This spring, St. Mary's County Department of Aging & Human Services is hosting a 4-week conference called "Keys to Senior Independence" at CSM Leonardtown. They are inviting HSMP Action Team members to participate as speakers. Speakers can present on a health topic of their choice. Available dates are March 19, March 26, April 2, and April 9. - <u>Tri-County Council of Southern Maryland</u> is slowly moving to fix its STS bus stops. They are waiting on permits for sign placements.
- St. Mary's College of Maryland is opening a new <u>food pantry</u> location on campus. It's operating as a food pantry for now, but they are anticipating to provide additional services in the future. Opening day is this Friday, Nov 17 from 11am-1pm at Waring Commons Complex (47830 College Dr in St Mary's City). For questions about this event reach out to <u>Bill Roberts</u>.
