ACEs

Violent Crimes

- The team is continuing to obtain and review data on youth crime.
 - Shan is continuing follow up with organizations to obtain the pre-pandemic (baseline) data and post-pandemic (2020 and after) data.
- The team held a brainstorm session and discussed:
 - As agencies and organizations, what are some things we can do to address the issue from a socio-emotional aspect? How can we implement these?
 - St. Mary's College of Maryland events
 - Kelsey proposed holding Mentoring Day in conjunction with an existing <u>concert</u> (The Jogo Project) on March 23. Activities include providing an afternoon tour of the college and attending the concert in the evening. Concert tickets are \$10.
 - Meeting with parents to provide education and encourage them to overcome stigmas.
 - Break-up mentors, community health professionals, and outreach into smaller, specialized groups designated to different areas and neighborhoods of the county.

 - VIT Co-chairs met with Sheila Murphy (Chief of Community Wellness, Cecil County Department of Community Services) and invited her to our next meeting (Partner Spotlight) to discuss how their LOSS team was started.
 - Kelsey Bush and Derek Adams will be tabling at the the Public Policy Forum on Black Youth Suicide on December 9.
 - Last week, Aniko and Derek invited members of the local NAACP 7025 Chapter to attend the forum as well!
