U.S. Census and Maryland Department of Planning Estimated Data:

- Between July 2015 and July 2019, the St. Mary's County population (ages 11-17) increased 0.3% (from 10,852 to 10,882).

Intake Case Forwarding Decisions (FY 2020):

- 24.6% of complaints were formalized, while 23.1% were informaled.

Intake Trends (FY 2018-2020):

- Total complaints decreased 27.3%.
- The percentage of total complaints authorized for formal petition decreased from 27.3% to 24.6%.
- Note: Many 2020 cases are still pending court action, so a disposition trend is not presented.

Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI) Risk Level (FY 2020):

- For Pre-Dispositional Detention admissions with a completed DRAI, 17.4% were High, 43.5% were Moderate, and 39.1% were Low.

Time Frames - Averages (FY 2020):

- Time from offense to intake referral date was 33.7 days.
- Time from intake referral date to case forwarding decision was 15.1 days.
- Time from case forwarding decision to sustained adjudication was 50.7 days.

Offense Category for Intake Cases (FY 2019-2020):

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence increased from 2.6% to 3.5%.
- The percentage of Felonies increased from 2.5% to 5.2%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors increased from 64.7% to 77.9%.

Commitments for VOP (FY 2018-2020):

- The percentage of commitments resulting from VOP decreased from 27.3% (6) to 0.0% (0).

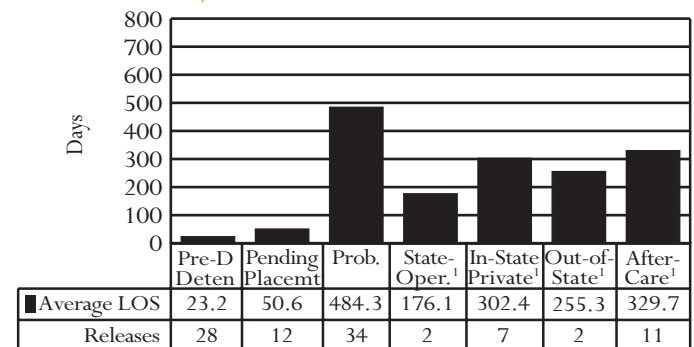

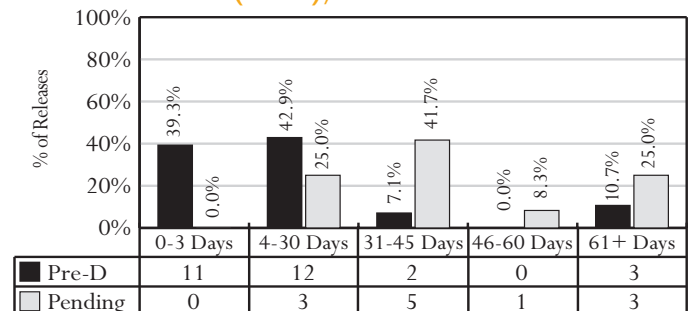
