- SMCHD's <u>Asthma program</u> is continuing to enroll children ages 2-18.
- SMCHD is continuing to host <u>smoking cessation classes</u> in partnership with MSMH. The <u>Emergency Adult Dental Program</u> is open to St. Mary's county residents. The new <u>TOPS</u> Chapter for SMCHD employees will host its first meeting on March 6!
- SMCHD's <u>Maternal Child & Elder Health</u> Unit is hosting a Community Baby shower on Saturday, May 4 from 9AM-12PM at Margaret Brent Middle School. Each person that registers will receive diapers, wipes, and be entered into a drawing for raffle prizes.
- During tax season, individuals can sign-up for health insurance through the Maryland Health Connection <u>Easy Enrollment Program</u>. Learn how to get a duplicate 1095-A tax form from Maryland Health Connection <u>here</u>.
- SMCHD's <u>Cancer Screening Program</u> offers colorectal cancer screening, as well as breast and cervical screenings.
 - March is Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month! Individuals aged 45 and up are recommended to get screened.

- HSMP's <u>Violence</u>, <u>Injury & Trauma Action Team</u> is hosting an ACEs Discussion panel on March 27 from 6-8:30PM at St. Mary's College of Maryland -Glendening Annex. Brianne Daly, SMCHD's Youth Engagement Coordinator, will be a featured panel member. Flier coming soon!
- <u>SMCFA</u> is hosting an <u>art contest</u> on "What does love look like to you?" for teens (aged 13-21) in Charles, Calvert and St. Mary's County. Entries will be accepted until March 8!
- The <u>Youth Mentoring Connection program</u> is now accepting <u>referrals</u> from the schools, teen court, and more! They just received a CHRC grant to expand behavioral health services at the school-based health centers.
- UME's <u>SNAP-Ed</u> Program is continuing to support Title I schools, food banks and farmers markets, as well as the <u>LMPP Community Garden!</u> They will be publishing a book soon that will be available free on their website. They are looking to partner with food banks/pantries for the spring.
- <u>Minority Outreach Coalition</u> has partnered with <u>Building Bridges</u> for its after school program. <u>UCAC</u> is now accepting applications for sponsors and vendors for its Juneteenth Celebration on Saturday, June 15, 2024.

2024 Brainstorming


- HSMP staff will be reaching out to organizations and partners that were identified <u>last month</u> to invite them the action team meetings.

- CDAT Initiatives for 2024:
 - Education

 - Include a Hispanic audience, with interpreters
 - Offer a series of workshops following the initial discussion panel
 - Physical activity
 - Continue to promoting free local resources, such as the TOPS program at SMCHD, walking groups and cooking demonstrations.
