The <u>ribbon-cutting ceremony</u> to celebrate the opening of Lexington Manor Passive Park <u>Community Garden</u> will take place on Saturday, April 6 at the <u>Cherry</u> <u>Blossom Festival</u>.

2024 HSMP Advocacy Agenda

- Chesapeake Climate Action Network continues to host its weekly <u>RENEW</u>
 <u>Act</u> Coalition Meetings. This prepares the community for natural disasters.
 - Karly has been attending meetings
 - Virtual Meetings every Monday from 4:00 5:00 PM

- Updates There is now a <u>draft</u> of the testimony in support of bill numbers SB0958 and HB1438!
- Fossil fuel companies would have to provide funding to bridge these financial gaps. The crossover date for the bill was March 18.
 Unfortunately, the bill did not pass. The resources are insufficient at this time. The bill has been set-up for potential success in 2025. We will continue to provide updates and advocate!

Food Security

- The group discussed initiatives to focus on reducing food waste and prompting composting. Ideas included:
 - Partnering with organizations to hold nutrition education (<u>SNAP-Ed</u>),
 promote agricultural partnerships, and gardening.
 - Organizations: <u>CDC</u>, <u>LMPP Community Garden</u> and University of Maryland Extension <u>Master Gardeners</u>.
 - The team worked on a <u>Jamboard</u> with community partners to brainstorm ideas for future education topics including composting, partnering with the community garden for classes on canning, food storage, and reducing food waste with composting bins.

Community Clean-Up


- Trash clean-up:
 - The group discussed needing long-term solutions for property management and neighborhoods in Lexington Park. Some communities don't have dumpsters or proper waste disposal. Improper waste disposal is taking place on Pegg Rd. as well
 - Sue will report back to the group in April. She is working on getting an article in the next newsletter discussing composting and other food-waste solutions for businesses and outreach events.
 - St. Mary's CDC Annual Trash Pick-Up Event June 1 (rain-date June 8) on Great Mills Rd. The CDC has previously provided dumpsters to Patuxent Homes and other vulnerable neighborhoods. SOMD Hauling and Summer Breeze donated dumpsters.
 - Action Item: Advocating to Department of Waste for another transfer station in Lexington Park that could be maintained by the county.
 - The group discussed proposing service days for community members with waste that don't have transportation to waste facilities in Ridge, Valley Lee, and California, MD.
- St. Mary's County Shred-Day and Medication/Syringe Take Back <u>events</u> will take place on April 13 in Leonardtown from 9 AM -1 PM.
- Mike proposed a FREE community fun run/walk on Great Mills Rd. with an area designated for clean-up with support and giveaways from vendors. "Trash Run" with LMPPCG - grand prize could be a compost bin!
