Food Security

- At the last meeting, the team worked on a Jamboard and discussed initiatives to focus on reducing food waste and prompting composting.
 - HSMP will be partnering with St. Mary's County Community Development Corporation (CDC) to promote the LMPP Community Garden! Partners and community members are encouraged to assist the garden by:
 - Volunteering during communal work days, joining the LMPPGC Volunteer Group on Facebook, and donating to the LMPPCG Amazon Wishlist.
 - Advertising the community garden on County Times, The Enterprise, and The Baynet
 - Promoting the garden's educational classes/events
 - Storytime at the garden, intermediate planting, companion planting composting, beekeeping

 - Sue was able to get the article published for the next newsletter discussing composting and other food-waste solutions for businesses and outreach events in the county newsletter.

Community Clean-Up

- Save the Date for St. Mary's CDC's Great Mills Road Community Clean Up <u>event</u> is on June 1, 2024.
 - The county is focused on private solutions for solid waste, which may not work for all community members.
 - EHAT can look at grant funding opportunities in the near future to support waste removal efforts in Lexington Park.
 - They are looking to create an environmental health hub to service residents that focuses on eco-friendly activities and solutions, safe disposal of hazardous materials, etc.
- HSMP may be able to partner with the CDC for an additional clean up event in the fall, but are currently at capacity for planning and coordination.
 - The group discussed community clean up initiatives in Lexington Park locations, such as Willows Rd, the community garden, and the library.




Communications
