

WHAT IS MORE TO EXPLORE?

The More To Explore Program encourages all community members to get outside and explore the amazing parks, historic sites, and farmers' markets that St. Mary's County has to offer!

HOW CAN PEOPLE PARTICIPATE?

Register and participate on Beanstack, or pick up a paper passport at your Library. Use the passport as your guide to get out and explore beautiful St. Mary's County! When you visit a site listed in the passport, look around for a green More to Explore marker. On each marker you will find a "secret code" (hint: it's usually a fitness word). Log the code in Beanstack or on your passport.

More to Explore is a collaborative effort of the Chronic Disease action team of the Healthy St. Mary's Partnership. The Chronic Disease Prevention Action Team of the Healthy St. Mary's Partnership brings together community organizations and residents to coordinate local action around chronic disease prevention and control.
