#### Unhoused Necessity Bags:

- Universal phone charger
- Reusable hand warmers or insect repellent, depending on the season
- SMCHD's VIT Unit provided tote bags, sunscreen, lip balm and hand sanitizer

#### Trauma Care Kit Action Bags:

- Universal phone charger
- SMCFA can provide 25 bags that contain a pair of pants, shirt, blanket, and water bottle
- Additional items needed: Gender-neutral hygiene products (wipes and tissues), bottles of water, long socks to stuff, blankets, lotion, and waterproof storage bags inside of action bags.
