

 - SMCHD's VIT Unit continues their Empower Hour mentoring program and is interested in SMCFA presenting on this topic


Partner Updates, Cont.

2025 Projects and Goals

- Dating Violence Education and prevention
 - What groups can we work with to complete this?
 - School system (PTA), stella's girls, GS troops, boys and girls club, mentoring connections, religious organizations
 - Teen education is on our advocacy agenda, let's keep pushing to get this information back in our schools.
 - Working with younger kids on being respectful
 - What already exists and what gaps are left?
 - Why don't they just leave event in October subcommittee interest?
 - October is domestic violence awareness month
 - Including teen dating violence
- Bullying education and prevention
 - What projects can we do to support this?
 - De-escalation programs.
 - SMC mediation offers services at the Health Hub offers workshops. Could we partner with them for an event?
 - Can people share any bullying education toolkits that we can repurpose?
 - Safe school year booklets includes info on relationships and bullying

2025 Projects and Goals

- Community education
 - What topics should we focus on? Where can this information be given out?
 - ACEs
 - HSMP did ACE panels last year. The VIT unit is certified ACE instructors! Use different information and what they learned. Tailoring different presentation- subcommittee?
 - Push out info on mentoring connections program
 - Suicide prevention
 - Collaborate with Unstoppable You Ministries' September event
 - Out of the darkness walk at SMCM in October
 - SMCPS mental health fair in May- we are meeting with Robin to explore this
 - Gun violence?
 - Community violence prevention day in June
 - The VIT Unit is doing community meetings in the Spring. Michelle to share if anyone is interested
 - Sexual assault prevention
 - SMCFA has a panel planned for April- flyer to come! Panelists needed!
 - Homelessness prevention?
 - Community Resource Day- HSMP would like to attend again
 - HSMP will reach out to the homelessness prevention board to see where we can partner
