#### 2025 Projects and Goals

- ACEs Event
  - 3 mini sessions for targeted demographics: teens, active military and families, and the Spanish-speaking community.
    - SMCHD's VIT Unit has 3 people certified in ACEs
  - **Teens**: could be a movie night that relates to ACEs with a short discussion after? Could we combine this with the BHAT/CDAT crossover?
    - Email Lauren your movie suggestions. This could be a documentary or an animated movie like Inside Out
  - Military: Could look like a presentation that we work on together
    - Lauren will reach out to FFS to see if we could collaborate with them to work on an event on base
  - Spanish-speaking community: we need to collaborate with the Language Team. It could be included with education they are already doing in this community.
    - Creating materials in Spanish to distribute instead of a presentation as a first step
    - Horowitz Center can ensure we use plain language before translation

#### 2025 Projects and Goals

- ACEs Event
  - SMCHD's VIT unit is certified on ACEs
  - Creating a series, the first part could be a general information on ACEs session while the following sessions could be focused for different demographics
    - Poll for demographic choices
      - Top 3 results were teens, active military and families, and the Spanish-speaking community
    - We will plan to work on the presentation together
    - There will be a shared document for people to drop their resources for the presentation
    - We could do a movie for younger demographics or panel for adult demographics
- Why Don't They Just Leave Panel Collaboration
  - We can collaborate with Southern Maryland Center for Family Advocacy for their event in October
  - We will plan to start our subcommittee in July
  - Reach out to <u>Taylor Spencer Davis</u> if you are interested in joining!
- Other event ideas?
  - Story hour using <u>Gizmo</u> from American Foundation for Suicide Prevention (3rd/4th grade)
    - At library, schools, parks & rec, summer camps, at park?
    - We could rent out space at Great Mills HS
