- MCF has 2 evidence based practices. A <u>referral</u> is needed; either a self-referral or by the school.
 - Chicago Parent <u>Program</u> is a 12 phase program to help elementary-aged children with behavioral health needs.
 - Family Check-up <u>model</u> is a strength based program. Free to residents in St. Mary's County, MCF facilitates.
