# MAPP 2.0 Background

- We are completing a Community Health Assessment (CHA)
  - The CHA will help establish our health priority areas for the next 6 years (and the HSMP Action Teams)
- Community Health Assessment uses MAPP 2.0 Framework
  - 3 phases
    - Phase 1: community partner input (starting now)
    - Phase 2: community surveys (January 2026)
    - Phase 3: continual improvement and result distribution
- We aim to have preliminary data ready to share at the 2026 Annual Meeting (late September) with our priority areas chosen by the end of November

# Survey Review

- The first survey is aimed at community partners to learn about their capacity
- The questions were pulled from the MAPP 2.0 but it is 50+ questions
- Goals
  - What questions are important to keep?
  - What questions could we remove?
  - Start distribution in early December
- Please review the survey and provide your input
  - **do not fill out the survey as this is a draft**

# Input on the CPA

- Question 26: Are all areas of focus needed?
- Question 30/31: added context to what addressing inequities externally means
- Question 12/13: change no to just no
- Can we add space for people who select yes under any of the options in Q37 to write how often (monthly/yearly/etc)
- Question 40 should have elaboration for the no option (maybe the yes option as well)
- Change 8 from MAPP to Community Health Assessment (CHA). DHS has a MAP program so we will refer to everything as CHA.
- Question 17: combine answers f & g
- Get rid of Q17 and change Q17 answer d to q18
- Move 19 to an answer in 17
- Q26 get rid of violence answer- listed twice
- If we do a stakeholder interview, focus on organizational accountability and Q40

# Input on the CPA

- Get rid of Q38 and add an other answer on Q37
- Q52- ask if it has helped with attendance through logic or adding another Q
- Q on community trust? What orgs are doing to continue to earn or regain trust in specific populations
- Play around with logic so that follow ups are only shown to those who answer a yes
- #57 . Can we change to, What types of communications does your organization engage in most often?
- #52 Focus on the things that work instead of everything that organizations do. “What options below did you find successful”
- If you are willing to schedule a key informant interview, please put a POC for if we have follow up questions/assessments
