Our food pantry uses a client choice model, which means families select their own groceries rather than receiving a prepackaged box/bag.

This approach-

Respects dignity – Families choose foods their household will actually eat.

Reduces waste – Less food is discarded or unused.

Supports health needs – Families can consider allergies, medical diets.

Feels more like shopping – Creating a welcoming, normal experience for neighbors in need.

Volunteers help guide families through the pantry, ensuring everyone receives a balanced selection.

This model reminds us that our ministry is not just about distributing food- its about serving people with compassion, respect and care.
