Maryland Solar Energy Equity Grant Program

Energy Select, in partnership with local nonprofits, has secured state funding to provide solar energy systems **at no cost** to eligible Maryland homeowners. This is not a loan or lease, it is a state-funded grant program designed to lower your energy bills.

Program Highlights:

- **100% Funded:** The program covers the cost of design and installation for solar PV systems.
- **Lower Electric Bills:** Generate your own clean power and reduce your monthly utility costs.
- **Energy Efficiency Upgrades:** Participants also receive (or must have recently completed) energy efficiency improvements like insulation or LED lighting to maximize savings.

How to Qualify:

1. **Home Ownership:** You must own a single-family home in Maryland and it must be your primary residence.
2. **Location:** Preference is given to homes in specific census tracts or "Overburdened and Underserved" communities. We can help with this!
3. **Income Eligibility:** Your household income must be at or below the following limits:
